In the month of January, we had no misdemeanor and no felony crimes reported to the Police Department. Officers were busy doing security checks of Borough properties along with traffic checks. The Borough Police Department responded to 3 EMS calls in the Borough. Officer Bickham served a PFA on a resident relative to an incident outside of the Borough. Officers assisted the Pa. State Police with a crash on Rt. 183 outside of the Borough. Officers handled many phone assignments relative to police matters which required no police action.

The Police Department checked sidewalks in the Borough after the recent storm most appeared cleared some did not but it was unclear due to the weather being over a few days then warming up if the sidewalks were cleared within the time required. We will be checking sidewalks to insure that residents comply with the Borough Ordinance hopefully all residents will clear their sidewalks of snow and ice, so we do not have to cite anyone this year.

The Police Department worked a total of 42 shifts covering 296 hours of patrol. Officers traveled 1182 miles while on patrol and in the performance of their duties. We purchased 137.386 gallons of fuel for a total cost of \$334.50 dollars this is the pump price with all taxes and does not show any discount. While on duty we conducted 90 traffic enforcement details and 50 security checks of properties in the Borough. The department issued 2 traffic citations, no non-traffic citations, and 6 parking tickets. The Police department in the month of January handled 43 calls for service.
