

## Service Details

Trash is collected one time per week on Wednesday. Each residence may set out up to six (6) containers each waste collection day. Containers may not weigh more than seventy five (75) pounds. Containers should be made of durable and rust-resistant materials having handles to facilitate collection and should have a close-fitting lid.

Recycling is collected every other week on Wednesday. Residents provide their own recycling containers. See the Recycling Guidelines included in this letter for what can and can't be recycled, as well as additional educational materials on recycling.

Spring Cleanup Bulk Items Day will be held annually on the second Saturday in June.

### Acceptable Bulk Items Include:

- Furniture
- Mattress and box springs
- Carpet rolled and tied (maximum length of 48")
- Washers, dryers, dishwashers
- Other household items too large for regular weekly collection
- Additional trash

### Special Handling Items:

Refrigerators, freezers, other appliances containing Freon® or other refrigerant. These items require special handling. Please keep them separate from your other spring cleanup items.

### Unacceptable Bulk items include but are not limited to:

- Liquids
- Paints and stains
- Chemicals
- Household hazardous waste
- Tires on rims
- Construction and demolition waste

## Single-Stream Recycling Guidelines

### Acceptable Items:

- Plastic containers #1 through #7. Must be narrow-neck, screw-top containers where the base is wider than the neck
- Aluminum and bi-metal food and beverage containers
- Glass, clear, green & brown bottles and jars
- Newsprint, cardboard (packing material must be removed), mixed paper (junk mail, magazines, glossies, telephone books, printer/copier paper), cereal boxes

### Unacceptable Items:

- Window or auto glass, drinking glasses, mirrors, light bulbs, ceramic, porcelain, microwave trays, cookware/bakeware
- Unnumbered plastic items
- Plastic bags
- Salad/deli containers
- Plastic food tubs
- Household items such as cooking pots, toasters, etc.
- Batteries
- Cardboard/paper with wax coating or liners
- Scrap metal and siding

### Special notice regarding electronic devices:

Did you know that Pennsylvania passed a law called the Covered Devices Recycling Act which prohibits residents from disposing of certain electronics as waste? Effective January 24, 2013, residents and businesses may no longer place these items at the curb as waste. Trash haulers are prohibited from collecting these items. These items include televisions, desktop computers, laptops, monitors, computer peripherals (keyboards, mouse, printer and speakers).
