In the month of December, we had no misdemeanor or felony crimes reported to the Police Department. Officers were busy patrolling the streets, conducting security checks of Borough and private property, and monitoring traffic.

The Borough received 28 calls for Police service. We had 5 calls for police services. There were 9 EMS calls 2 of which the Borough police responded to, 7 of which PSP was dispatched but did not respond to. The Department conducted 3 traffic stops for violations of the vehicle code in the Borough. The Borough had death investigation which PSP covered to our knowledge it was natural causes. There was 1 domestic reported covered by PSP. Other calls include Fire Alarm, Burglar Alarm, Reckless driver, vehicle crash, phone wires down, illegal burning, and disorderly conduct.

Officers handled many phone assignments relative to police matters which required no police action.

The Department is here to service the community but requires citizens reporting incidents to the police Dept. and being willing and able to identify suspects involved.

Bernville Borough had 28 Police calls 13 calls between 7am -3pm, 12 calls between 3pm-11pm and 3 call between 11pm-7am.

The Borough police handled 10 calls for service, PSP received 18 calls for service

The Police Department worked a total of 20 shifts covering 154 hours of service. Officers traveled 729 miles while on patrol and in the performance of their duties. We purchased 71.007 gallons of fuel for a total cost of \$204.00 dollars this is the pump price with all taxes and does not show any discount. While on duty officers conducted traffic enforcement monitoring of our new speed enforcement sign which was deployed 3 times in the Borough. The department issued 7 traffic citations, 1 non-traffic citations, and 4 parking tickets. The Police department in the month of December handled 10 calls for service. PSP received 18 calls for service and responded 7. There was a total of 28 police service calls.
