In the month of February, we had no misdemeanor or felony crimes reported to the Police Department.

I was busy patrolling the streets, conducting security checks of Borough and private property, and monitoring traffic.

The Borough received 39 calls for Police service. We had 4 calls for police services. There were 8 ALS EMS calls, 2 BLS EMS, 1 lift Assist, 3 welfare checks, and 1 over dose for a total of 15 medical call of which the Borough police responded to 5. PSP was dispatched but did not respond to 10. The Department conducted 6 traffic stops for violations of the vehicle code in the Borough. There were reports of 4 domestics reported. Other calls include a medical Alarm, 2 people were locked out of their vehicle and assisted by police. We also had 2 disorderly conduct calls. 2 Reckless drivers on Rt. 183. There was 1 house Fire in the Borough covered by PSP fire Marshal.

The Chief worked the snow emergency towing 3 vehicles and issued 8 parking tickets for parking on the emergency route.

I handled many phone assignments relative to police matters which required no police action.

The Department is here to service the community but requires citizens reporting incidents to the police Dept. and being willing and able to identify suspects involved.

Bernville Borough had 39 Police calls 19 calls between 7am -3pm, 15 calls between 3pm-11pm and 5 call between 11pm-7am. The Borough police handled 18 calls for service, PSP received 21 calls for service 10 of those calls were medical calls that they do not respond to

The Police Department worked a total of 20 shifts covering 160 hours of service. Officers traveled 1515 miles while on patrol and in the performance of their duties. We purchased 88.729 gallons of fuel for a total cost of \$254.00 dollars this is the pump price with all taxes and does not show any discount. The department issued 8 traffic citations, 1 non-traffic citations, and 8 parking tickets. The Police department in the month of February handled 18 calls for service. PSP received 21 calls for service and responded to 11. There was a total of 39 police service calls.
