In the month of March, we had no misdemeanor or felony crimes reported to the Police Department.

I was busy patrolling the streets, conducting security checks of Borough and private property, and monitoring traffic.

The Borough received 31 calls for Police service. We had 3 calls for police services. There were 6 ALS EMS calls, 1 lift Assist, there was a total of 7 medical call of which the Borough police responded to 2. PSP was dispatched but did not respond to 5. The Department conducted 11 traffic stops for violations of the vehicle code in the Borough. There were reports of 2 domestic incidents both at the same address. Other calls include 3 Alarms, 1 person was locked out of her vehicle and assisted by police. 1 Reckless driver on Rt. 183 and 1 vehicle crash also on Rt. 183. There was hazmat call for a leaking gas from a motor that fire handled with no hazmat response to the Borough

I handled many phone assignments relative to police matters which required no police action.

The Department is here to service the community but requires citizens reporting incidents to the police Dept. and being willing and able to identify suspects involved.

Bernville Borough had 31 Police calls 13 calls between 7am -3pm, 16 calls between 3pm-11pm and 2 call between 11pm-7am. The Borough police handled 18 calls for service, PSP received 13 calls for service 5 of those calls were medical calls that they do not respond to

The Police Department worked a total of 20 shifts covering 160 hours of service. Officers traveled 1070 miles while on patrol and in the performance of their duties. We purchased 100.802 gallons of fuel for a total cost of \$303.00 dollars this is the pump price with all taxes and does not show any discount. The department issued 12 traffic citations, 1 non-traffic citations, and no parking tickets. There was a total of 31 police service calls.
